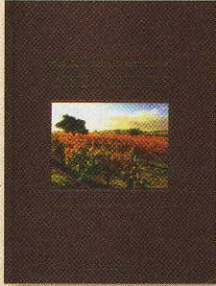


Wine Reading

Holmes is also celebrating another book launch he contributed to,

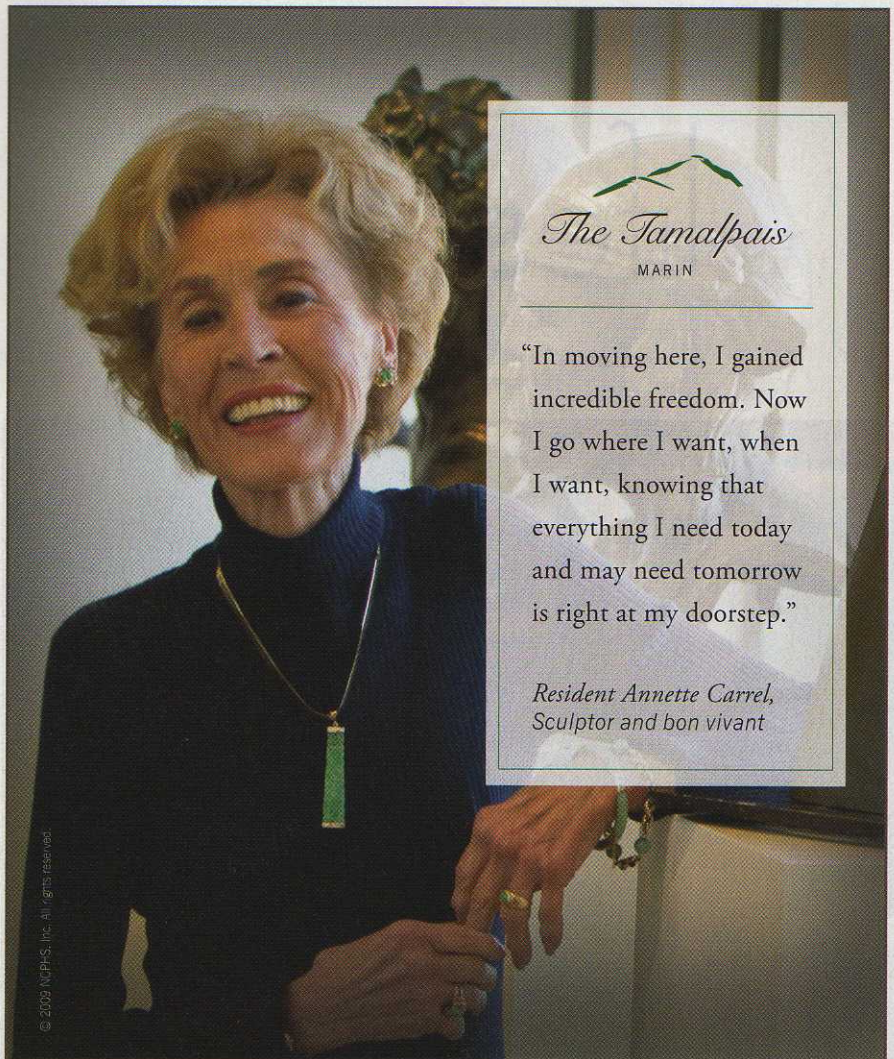
Passion for Pinot, written by Jorday Mackay.
